STAY-AT-HOME INFORMATION

We welcome you to BYU Mission Ready! The following information will help you during the week. Please read the information carefully. If you have any questions, please contact us at 801-422-7692 or email missionready@byu.edu.

Classes, Activities, and Devotionals

As a stay-at-home participant of Mission Ready, you are expected to attend all daytime classes and evening activities including morning gospel study. You must check in each morning with your teacher in your assigned district room at the BYU Conference Center between 8:15 and 8:30 a.m. Please check-in between 8:00 and 8:15 a.m. on Thursday.

You must remain on-campus until you check out with your counselor each evening (see schedule below). You will receive a full agenda when you check in.

Failure to check in or out will result in you being sent home for the day and you may not be allowed to participate in future classes or activities.

Transportation

All stay-at-home participants must be dropped off and picked up at the BYU Conference Center daily during the designated check-in and check-out period. You must wait for your ride with a member of the Mission Ready staff. Evening pick-up times are as follows:

Tuesday, July 24	9:45-10:00 p.m.
Wednesday, July 25:	9:00-9:15 p.m.
Thursday, July 26:	9:15-9:30 p.m.
Friday, July 27:	10:00-10:15 p.m.

If you are driving to campus, you may park in the lot adjacent to the west side of the BYU Conference Center. Participants staying in campus housing may not ride in a stay-at-home participant's car and participants who drive themselves will not be permitted to leave campus or move their vehicle during the day.

Meals

Lunch will be provided daily at the BYU Conference Center. You will receive a meal card for daily dinners (Monday through Friday). If you lose your meal card, please speak with a member of the staff. A replacement card costs \$2.
